SELF-CONTROL by Debby Holland Diaz MA ThM

One afternoon long ago I was riding my moped across the remote, rocky part of the island where I worked in Spain. I saw no sign of life until, behind a huge rock, I came upon two boys throwing stones violently on the ground. As I rode closer, I realized they were killing a cat! I zoomed over to them and jumped off my moped just as the cat's eyes were closing in death!

"Os mato!" I shouted at the boys, "I'll kill you!" I will never forget the look on their faces—they couldn't have been more than seven years old. They ran and I rode after them, but almost immediately they scrambled up some rocks and disappeared. I sat there on my moped, trembling. I had never been so enraged in all my life, but—*Que horror*! How horrible of me to threaten and chase two little boys, me the language teacher who loved kids who wanted to get married and raise a family! For the first time in years, I prayed......

I believe there is a reason **self-control** is the last of the nine Gifts of The Spirit in Galatians 5:22-23. I've been writing about them since Rev. Fils-Aime asked me to do the devotionals for the monthly newsletter so beautifully edited by Deacon Sharrata Hunt; she helpfully suggested "Goodness" for the February issue; and I followed that with Faith, Meekness and now **Self-Control**. As we study these gifts, we find that the English translations of several of these important words vary. For example, the KJV (King James Version) calls self-control "temperance." God, whose Holy Word was first written in Hebrew, Aramaic and Greek and eventually translated into several versions of many languages, wants this final Gift of the Spirit, **self-control**, to stick in our minds!

God wants us to have control over ourselves! **Self-control** is a hallmark of the mature Christian who can speak honestly without hurting oneself or anyone else! God gave each of us the range of human emotions and wants us to experience them, not to repress them but to express them in a way that is pleasing to God! For example, the Bible says, "be angry and sin not." (Ephesians 4:26. KJV) God's Word does not forbid getting mad. God's Own Son our Savior Jesus Christ got angry at religious hypocrisy and greed.

We can be angry at injustice and say or do something about it-- like that amazing Christian preacher who asked all his hearers to be angry with him because three young Voting Rights Advocates were murdered and martyred together in Mississippi but could not be buried in the same cemetery. We remember Civil Rights Era examples of anger peacefully displayed and controlled. What **self-control** examples come to your mind?

God knows each one of us better than we know ourselves. God understands and speaks all the languages of the world! Let us all ask God to guide each of our emotions because God cherishes every part of each of us, including the way we feel. Let us trust God to give us the right kind of **self-control** at the right time! Thank you Jesus!

CONCERNING MARRIAGE

Do not deprive each other except perhaps by mutual consent and for a time, so that you may devote yourselves to prayer. Then come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of **self-control**. 1 Corinthians 7:5

QUALIFICATIONS FOR LEADERSHIP—Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task. Now the overseer is to be above reproach, faithful to his wife, temperate, **self-controlled**, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. 1 Timothy 3:2

People will be lovers of themselves...proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy,...without **self-control**, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God— 2 Timothy 3:2-4

Teach the older men to be temperate, worthy of respect, **self-controlled**, and sound in faith, in love and in endurance.

Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to teach what is good. Then they can urge the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be **self-controlled** and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.

Similarly, encourage the young men to be self-controlled. Titus 2:2-6

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. 2 Peter 1:5-7
