## Committed Team Volunteer

### Purpose:

**The Committed Team Volunteer** walks with individuals who are ready to take formal next steps towards becoming a member of CBC, including baptism, membership class, and connecting to leadership development opportunities. This role ensures clarity, encouragement, and faithful accompaniment.

### Committed Volunteer Responsibilities:

- Receive prospective member information from the Core Team or candidate interactions
- Ask and discern readiness for next steps
- Guide individuals through baptism, membership class, and interviews
- Coordinate Right Hand of Fellowship with Senior Pastor
- Identify leadership potential
- Track leadership training and mentoring
- Maintain Planning Center – People records
- Serve as light and salt in service to the LORD

### Committed Volunteer Requirements:

- Spiritually mature and relationally grounded
- Comfortable asking clear, gracious questions
- Comprehension of and/or experience with leadership roles
- Organized and dependable
- Desire to help others grow into responsibility
- Must be a member of CBC
- Need at least one team member who is comfortable working on a computer
